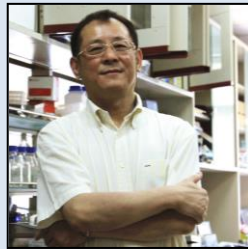

*"It is still a long way to control this disease. I may not succeed for my lifetime, but I hope the younger generation would carry forward this course to control the disease."*



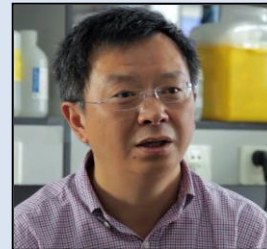
